First Corinthians – The Church and the Christian Community by Tim Gray examines what it means to be in communion with Christ. The conflict of the early Christians in Corinth is in many ways similar to our struggles today as Christians. With divisions, immorality, persecution, and other trials of the faithful, the message of St. Paul to the Corinthians is a much-needed message for our own times. St. Paul taught the Corinthians about the nature of grace and the Church as the body of Christ. Most importantly, he introduced the Corinthian Christians to the most powerful gift of all, the Eucharist.
